- 3. A total of six (6) scholarships will be awarded. Each will be worth \$500.00 and will be non-renewable.
- 4. The scholarship must be used at an accredited university, college, or vocational institution. The scholarship funds will be issued directly to the university or vocational institution attended by the student.
- 5. A committee selected by the Northfork Electric Board of Trustees will act as The Scholarship Committee. Items for consideration will be: Academic Ability, School and Community Involvement, Letters of Recommendation, and Financial Need. The decision of the Board will be final.
